DISCIPLINARY ORDER AND UNDERTAKING REPRIMANDING AN AGENT

Be it remembered that Gentry Rowsey Knapp ("Respondent") appeared before the Securities Commissioner of the State of Texas ("Securities Commissioner") and consented to the entry of this Order and the Findings of Fact and the Conclusions of Law contained herein.

FINDINGS OF FACT

1. Respondent has waived (a) Respondent's right to notice and hearing in this matter; (b) Respondent's right to appear and present evidence in this matter; (c) Respondent's right to appeal this Order; and (d) all other procedural rights granted to Respondent by The Securities Act, TEX. REV. CIV. STAT. ANN. art. 581-1 et seq. (Vernon 1964 & Supp. 2000) ("Texas Securities Act"), and the Administrative Procedure Act, TEX. GOV'T CODE ANN. § 2001.001 et seq. (Vernon Supp. 2000) ("Administrative Procedure Act").
2. Respondent has filed an application for registration with the Securities Commissioner as an agent of Premier Group, Inc.
3. Premier Group, Inc. is affiliated with Premier Minerals, Inc. and serves as the dealer offering its securities.
4. Respondent has offered for sale and sold said securities on behalf of Premier Minerals, Inc. at a time when said securities were not registered as required by

Section 7 of the Texas Securities Act.

5. Respondent has offered for sale and sold securities on behalf of Premier Minerals, Inc. at a time when he was not registered with the Securities Commissioner as required by Section 12 of the Texas Securities Act.

CONCLUSIONS OF LAW

1. Pursuant to Section 14. A(6) of the Texas Securities Act, the foregoing violations constitute bases for the issuance of an order reprimanding Respondent.
2. Pursuant to Section 23-1 of the Texas Securities Act, the foregoing violations constitute bases for the issuance of an order assessing an administrative fine against Respondent.

UNDERTAKING

1. Respondent agrees that he will not offer for sale or sell securities from within the State of Texas or to a Texas resident unless he is registered with the Securities Commissioner as required by Section 12 of the Texas Securities Act, or is exempt from the registration requirements thereof.
2. Respondent agrees that he will not offer for sale or sell securities from within the State of Texas or to a Texas resident unless said securities are registered with the Securities Commissioner as required by Section 7 of the Texas Securities Act, or are exempt from the registration requirements thereof.


ORDER

1. It is therefore ORDERED that the registration of Gentry Rowsey Knapp as an agent of Premier Group, Inc. is hereby GRANTED.
2. It is further ORDERED that Gentry Rowsey Knapp SHALL COMPLY with the terms of the Undertaking as set forth herein.
3. It is further ORDERED that Gentry Rowsey Knapp is hereby REPRIMANDED.
4. It is further ORDERED that Gentry Rowsey Knapp is ASSESSED AN ADMINISTRATIVE FINE in the amount of Three Thousand Dollars (\$3,000.00). Payment shall be made by delivery of a cashier's check to the Securities Commissioner in the amount of Three Thousand Dollars (\$3,000.00), payable to the State of Texas, contemporaneously with the delivery of this Order.

ACKNOWLEDGMENT

On the 10th day of January, 2000, Gentry Rowsey Knapp ("Respondent"), personally appeared before me, executed the foregoing Order, and acknowledged that:

1. Respondent has read the foregoing Order;
2. Respondent has been fully advised of his rights under the Texas Securities Act and the Administrative Procedure Act;
3. Respondent knowingly and voluntarily consents to the entry of the foregoing Order and the Findings of Fact, Conclusions of Law, and Undertaking contained therein; and,
4. Respondent, by consenting to the entry of the foregoing Order, has knowingly and voluntarily waived his rights as set forth therein.
