### AGREED CEASE AND DESIST ORDER

Be it remembered that Hew-Tex Oil & Gas Corporation ("Respondent Hew-Tex"), by and through its President, Peter H. Hewett, Peter H. Hewett ("Respondent Hewett"), William L. Roney, Jr. ("Respondent Roney"), and Ronald K. Allen ("Respondent Allen"), individually (collectively "Respondents"), appeared before the Securities Commissioner of Texas ("Securities Commissioner") and consented to the entry of this Order and the Findings of Fact and Conclusions of Law contained herein.

### FINDINGS OF FACT

1. Respondents have waived (a) Respondents' right to notice and hearing in this matter; (b) Respondents' right to appear and present evidence in this matter; (c) Respondents' right to appeal this Order; and (d) all other procedural rights granted to Respondents by The Securities Act, TEX. REV. CIV. STAT. ANN. art. 581-1 et seq. (Vernon 1964 & Supp. 2004) ("Texas Securities Act"), and the Administrative Procedure Act, TEX. GOV'T CODE ANN. §2001.001 et seq. (Vernon 2000 & Supp. 2004) ("Administrative Procedure Act").
2. Respondent Hew-Tex is a Texas corporation formed on or about May 21, 1990, and maintains a last known address at 11222 Richmond Ave., Suite 190, Houston, Texas 77082.

3. Respondent Hewett is the President of Respondent Hew-Tex and maintains a last known business address at 11222 Richmond Ave, Suite 190, Houston, Texas 77082.
4. Respondent Roney is the Vice President of Respondent Hew-Tex and maintains a last known business address at 11222 Richmond Ave, Suite 190, Houston, Texas 77082.
5. Respondent Allen is an employee of Respondent Hew-Tex and maintains a last known business address at 11222 Richmond Ave, Suite 190, Houston, Texas 77082.
6. Respondents have offered for sale in Texas "Units" representing percentage working interests in an oil and gas well to be drilled in St. Landry Parish, Louisiana, known as the Port Barre project.
7. The Units were not registered by qualification, notification or coordination and no permit has been granted for their sale in Texas.
8. Respondents were not registered with the Securities Commissioner as dealers or agents at any time material hereto.
9. In connection with the offer for sale of the above-described Units, Respondents intentionally failed to disclose the following material facts:
  - A. On or about January 5, 1999, the Pennsylvania Securities Commission ("Pennsylvania") issued a Summary Order to Cease and Desist against Hew-Tex Oil & Gas Corporation, Peter H. Hewett, Hew-Tex/Scott Joint Venture and Brandon Fields. Pennsylvania found that Respondent Hew-Tex, by and through its representatives, violated the Pennsylvania Securities Act of 1972. Pennsylvania ordered Hew-Tex Oil & Gas Corporation, Peter H. Hewett, Hew-Tex/Scott Joint Venture and Brandon Fields to immediately Cease and Desist from offering and selling securities in the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania.
  - B. Respondent Hew-Tex had paid commissions to unlicensed sales persons for the sales of Units in the oil and gas projects promoted by Hew-Tex.

#### CONCLUSIONS OF LAW

1. The above-described Units are "securities" as that term is defined by Section 4.A of the Texas Securities Act.
2. Respondents violated Section 7 of the Texas Securities Act by offering securities for sale in Texas at a time when the securities were not registered with the Securities Commissioner.

3. Respondents violated Section 12 of the Texas Securities Act by offering securities for sale in Texas without being registered pursuant to the provisions of Section 12 of the Texas Securities Act.
4. Respondents have engaged in fraud in connection with the offer for sale and sale of securities.
5. The forgoing violations constitute bases for issuance of an Agreed Cease and Desist Order pursuant to Section 23.A of the Texas Securities Act.


ORDER

1. It is therefore ORDERED that Respondents immediately CEASE AND DESIST from offering for sale any security in Texas until the security is registered with the Securities Commissioner or is offered for sale pursuant to an exemption from registration under the Texas Securities Act.
2. It is further ORDERED that Respondents immediately CEASE AND DESIST from acting as securities dealers or agents in Texas until Respondents are registered with the Securities Commissioner or are acting pursuant to an exemption from registration under the Texas Securities Act.
3. It is further ORDERED that Respondents immediately CEASE AND DESIST from engaging in any fraud in connection with the offer for sale of any security in Texas.
