ORDER GRANTING RESPONDENTS' MOTION TO SET ASIDE ORDER AFFIRMING EMERGENCY CEASE AND DESIST ORDER

1. On March 29, 2005, the above named Respondents submitted a *Request To Set Aside Order Affirming Emergency Cease and Desist Order, Or, In The Alternative, Motion For A Rehearing* ("Respondents' Request") in response to the *Order Affirming Emergency Cease and Desist Order*, issued by the Securities Commissioner on March 23, 2005.
2. Based on the requirements of Section 23-2.C.(2) of The Securities Act, TEX. REV. CIV. STAT. ANN. art. 581-1 et seq. (Vernon 1964 & Supp. 2004-2005)

("Texas Securities Act"), the Respondents' *Request For Hearing* submitted on or about January 18, 2005 is sufficient to satisfy the requirements for a hearing before the State Office of Administrative Hearings.

3. The request to set aside the Order Affirming Emergency Cease and Desist Order is hereby granted and the matter will be reset for a hearing before the State Office of Administrative Hearings based on the original merits of the Emergency Cease and Desist Order, No. ENF-04-CDO-1579.
4. The original Emergency Cease and Desist Order, No. ENF-04-CDO-1579, shall remain in full force and effect pending the outcome of the hearing at the State Office of Administrative Hearings.

IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED that the Order Affirming Emergency Cease and Desist Order be set aside and a hearing on the merits of the original Emergency Cease and Desist Order, No. ENF-CDO-04-1579, be reset before the State Office of Administrative Hearings.
