AGREED ORDER SETTING ASIDE ORDER NO. ENF-15-CDO-1740

Be it remembered that Woodbridge Mortgage Investment Fund 3, LLC, by and through its controlling person, Robert Shapiro, and Robert Shapiro, individually, (collectively "Respondents") by and through counsel, Neal Sullivan, appeared before the Securities Commissioner of the State of Texas ("Securities Commissioner") and consented to the entry of this Order and the Findings of Fact contained herein.

FINDINGS OF FACTS

1. Respondents have waived (a) Respondents' right to notice and a hearing in this matter; (b) Respondents' right to appear and present evidence in this matter; (c) Respondents' right to appeal this Order; and (d) all other procedural rights granted to Respondents by The Securities Act, Tex. Rev. Civ. Stat. Ann. arts. 581-1 to 581-44 (West 2010 & Supp. 2015) ("Texas Securities Act"), and the Administrative Procedure Act, (Tex. Gov't Code Ann. §2001.001 to 2001.902 (West 2008 & Supp. 2015) ("Administrative Procedure Act).
2. Respondent Woodbridge Mortgage Investment Fund 3, LLC ("Respondent Woodbridge") is a Delaware limited liability company and maintains last known addresses of 14225 Ventura Boulevard, Suite 100, Sherman Oaks, California

91423 and 123 N.W. 13th Street, Suite 309, Boca Raton, Florida 33432. Neal Sullivan, an attorney at Sidley Austin LLP, who maintains a last known address at 1501 K Street, N.W., Washington, DC 20005, represents Respondent Woodbridge in connection with this matter.

3. Respondent Robert H. Shapiro ("Respondent Shapiro") is the controlling person of Respondent Woodbridge and maintains last known addresses of 14225 Ventura Boulevard, Suite 100, Sherman Oaks, California 91423 and 123 N.W. 13th Street, Suite 309, Boca Raton, Florida 33432. Neal Sullivan, an attorney at Sidley Austin LLP, who maintains a last known address at 1501 K Street, N.W., Washington, DC 20005, represents Respondent Shapiro in connection with this matter.
4. Respondents have offered for sale and sold First Position Commercial Mortgage Notes ("The Note Program") in Texas.
5. On July 17, 2015, the Securities Commissioner entered Emergency Cease and Desist Order No. ENF-15-CDO-1740 ("the Emergency Order") against Respondents and other parties. The Emergency Order has remained in full force and effect through the date of the entry of this Order.
6. On or about August 20, 2015, Respondents filed a timely request for a hearing to modify or set aside the Emergency Order.
7. By executing this Order, and upon entry of this Order by the Securities Commissioner, Respondents withdraw their request for a hearing at the State Office of Administrative Hearings ("SOAH") solely as that request relates to Respondents Woodbridge and Shapiro as the parties have settled all matters in controversy. The matter will not be set for hearing on SOAH's docket with respect to Respondents Woodbridge and Shapiro and will not be subject to appeal by Respondents.
8. Respondents agree to comply with the Undertaking filed contemporaneously with the entry of this Order.

CONCLUSIONS OF LAW

1. The Note Program investment is a "security" as that term is defined by Section 4.A of the Texas Securities Act.
2. Respondents violated Section 7 of the Texas Securities Act by offering securities for sale in Texas at a time when the securities were not registered with the Securities Commissioner.

3. The foregoing violations constitute bases for the issuance of an Agreed Order pursuant to Section 23.A of the Texas Securities Act.

ORDER

1. It is therefore ORDERED that the Emergency Cease and Desist Order, Order No. ENF-15-CDO-1740, is set aside by this Agreed Order solely and exclusively as to Respondents Woodbridge and Shapiro.
2. It is further ORDERED that Respondents immediately CEASE AND DESIST from offering for sale or selling The Note Program in Texas until The Note Program is registered with the Securities Commissioner or is offered for sale and sold pursuant to an exemption from registration under the Texas Securities Act.

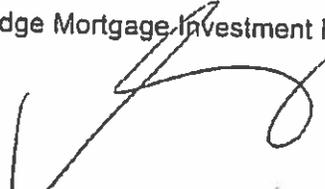
